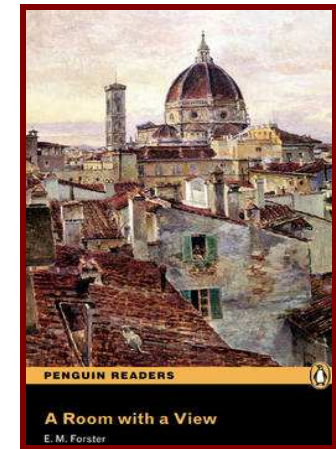

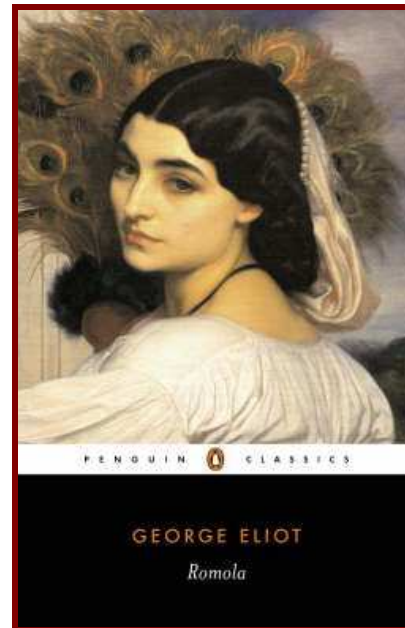

All British Institute students have automatic membership of the Library for the duration of their course.

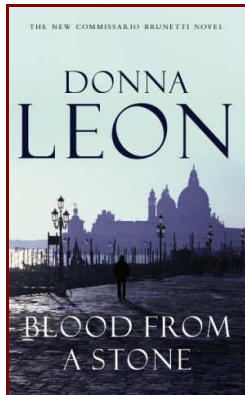
Members can borrow up to four books at a time for up to one month, a refundable deposit of €25 is payable.

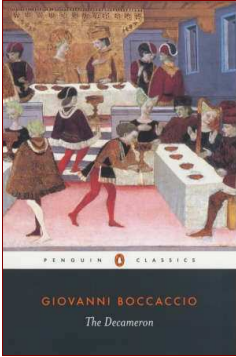

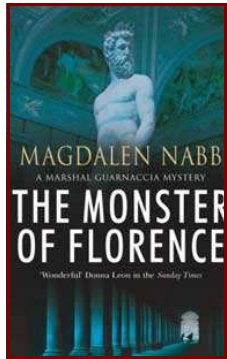
